### NARRATIVE

I responded to 2450 SW 90th Ave in reference to a DCF intake (#2025-436722-01) that was forwarded to Miami-Dade Schools Police Communication Center for an incident involving a student (V-1) and his teacher, Mr. Alejandro Suarez (OF-1). The incident occurred at 9393 SW 29th Ter, Rockway Middle School, on Friday, December 19, 2025 at approximately 1:10pm.

Upon arrival, I spoke with V-1 who explained while he was walking in line with his classmates back to class he stepped out of line to go ask OF-1 a question. V-1 tapped OF-1's shoulder to get his attention and in response OF-1 turned around to face V-1 and began hitting him in his chest area with his fingertips. VI-1 informed OF-1 that he touched his nipples and OF-1 turned back around ignoring VI-1's statement. V-1 stated he tapped his teacher again and repeated his question. OF-1 then turned around facing V-1 "flexing himself as a scary figure". V-1 reacted by taking two steps back, OF-1 then followed him and proceeded to strike V-1's arm with his shin causing V-1 to crouch down in pain. Once in the classroom V-1 asked to go to the nurse's station and stated to the teacher "You assaulted me". OF-1 stated in response "You want to see what an assault is?". They were located on the pathway between the 1100 and 1200 building when this incident occurred. V-1 appeared to have a visible bruise on his left forearm.

V-1 advised the nurse and Ms. Mayte Fuentes, the Assistant Principal (IO-1) of the incident. IO-1 was able to view video footage and gathered witness statements from other students.

After dismissal, V-1 parents returned to the school to speak with IO-1 about the incident. The parents were informed that the school would initiate an investigation and could not provide any further information. They were also advised to take V-1 to the hospital if they wished and expenses would be covered by the school's insurance. Law enforcement was not notified on the day of the incident.

On the following day, December 20th, 2025, V-1's mother, [REDACTED] (IO-2), and his older sister, Ms. Melissa Aguila (IO-3), took V-1 to Nicklaus Children's Hospital to get examined. The emergency room physician, Dr. Christina Perez- Arche reported the incident to DCF via web.

Miami- Dade Schools Police Sergeant C. Lascano (#0638) was notified and responded to the scene. GIU was notified and will assume the investigation.

V-1's statement form, DCF intake form, and photos of the V-1 were forwarded to GIU. Case card provided.

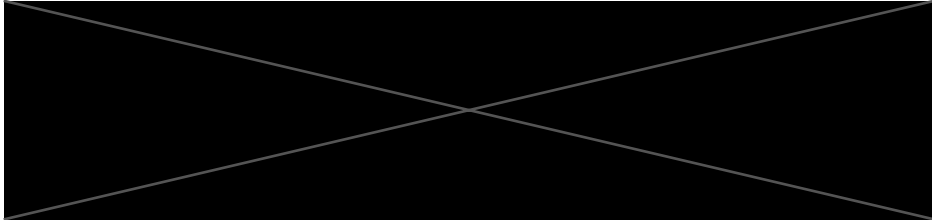

On Monday, January 5, 2026, Miami-Dade Schools Police Sgt. L. Webb (Badge #510) assigned me as the lead investigator reference Miami-Dade Schools Police Department Case #25-1223009282, regarding an allegation that Mr. Alejandro Suarez, Teacher (IO1) kicked MM (IO2) in the forearm, causing bruising, on December 19, 2025.

This case was criminally investigated and exceptionally cleared on January 8, 2026, and was subsequently placed under administrative review as a Preliminary Personnel Investigation under G-52248.

On this same date, I made contact with Assistant Principal Mayte Fuentes (RP1), who reported that on Friday, December 19, 2025, in the afternoon, she was advised by Nurse Nicole Erdmann (RP2) that MM walked into the clinic stating his forearm was hurting. Ms. Erdmann stated she observed what appeared to be a bump with red dots around it on MM's forearm. Ms. Erdmann further stated she asked MM how the injury occurred, and MM initially did not want to disclose the incident due to another student being present in the room. After the unknown student left the clinic, MM stated that a teacher had kicked him.

Ms. Erdmann reported the incident to Ms. Fuentes, who then initiated a Personnel Investigative Model (PIM) Form. Ms. Fuentes stated that due to it being the last day of school prior to winter break and dismissal about to begin, she did not notify the school resource officer at that time.

Ms. Erdmann declined to provide a written statement.

I then interviewed MM, who stated that as his class was walking back from lunch to the classroom, he tapped Mr. Suarez on the shoulder to ask a question regarding his grade on a project. Mr. Suarez turned around and began hitting him in the chest, touched his nipple, and then turned back around to continue walking. When MM did not receive an answer to his question, he tapped Mr. Suarez on the shoulder again and Mr. Suarez turned around, causing MM to take two steps back, and kicked MM in the arm with his shin.

MM further stated he crouched down in pain for approximately five seconds. MM then stated to Mr. Suarez, "you assaulted me," to which Mr. Suarez responded, "You want to see what assault is?" MM then asked to go see the nurse, spoke with Ms. Fuentes, provided a statement and was sent to his next period.

MM provided a written statement.

I then interviewed [REDACTED] (W), who stated he was walking in front of MM when he observed Mr. Suarez turn around and walk back toward MM. [REDACTED] stated he saw MM block the kick with his arm. [REDACTED] then heard MM state, "Yo, that hurt, that was a hard kick."

[REDACTED] provided the school with a written statement.

On this same date, I made contact with [REDACTED] mother of MM. Ms. [REDACTED] requested that moving forward I speak with her daughter, Melissa Marrero, MM's sister, as she was appointing her as MM's guardian. I then made contact with Ms. Marrero, who stated she works for a law firm and that the firm would be representing MM and would be filing a lawsuit against Miami-Dade County Public Schools.

On January 8, 2026, I spoke with Ms. Johnette Hardiman, Assistant State Attorney. After reviewing the CCTV footage, it was determined that the State would not be prosecuting the case against Mr. Suarez.

On January 9, 2026, Ms. Marrero was contacted via telephone and advised of the State Attorney's Office decision.

On January 12, 2026, Mr. Suarez reported to the Miami-Dade Schools Police Headquarters located at 3300 NW 27th Avenue, Miami, FL 33142, accompanied by colleague, [REDACTED] retired teacher from Rockway Middle. Mr. Suarez was not a Union Member of the Miami-Dade County Public Schools United Teachers of Dade (UTD), signed a waiver of representation and provided a written statement.

"On December 19, 2025, around 11:00 PM, I picked up my students up from lunch at the cafeteria. On the way to class, students were excited and hyper, as it was the last day before winter break. As we were walking back to class, some students started poking me on the back and I asked them to stop. Continuing forward to class, MM poked me on the back and I turned to tell him to 'stop!' I turned to continue back to class, almost immediately MM poked me again, I turned and he moved to the side, I swiped my leg in his direction and he put his arm down towards my leg making contact. We continued to the classroom where he said his arm hurt and that I 'assaulted him.' As his law teacher, I replied 'I didn't assault you MM but I can show you what assault is.' At this point I saw his arm which had a small bruise and asked him If he wanted to go to the nurse. He said, 'yes', and left to the office.

The interview was concluded.
